

## Western Wayne Family Health Centers

WWFHC operates three community health centers, all in medically underserved areas. Locations are in Inkster, Taylor and Lincoln Park and are open to all, regardless of where they live...or don't live. Community health centers offer primary care for all ages, obstetrics and gynecology, general dentistry and integrated behavioral health services. Homeless persons and families can access services—which are offered on a sliding fee scale based on income and most insurance (including Medicaid and Healthy Michigan Plan) are accepted. Proof of income is needed, and letters verifying patients are clients of a homeless services program are accepted to loosen some documentation requirements. Application counselors at all locations can assist people and families to apply for insurance coverage through Healthy Michigan Plan and Medicaid, as well as through the health insurance Marketplace.

Appointments can be made by calling the centers or stopping by—and walk in appointments are welcome. All three are open Monday through Friday.

- The Inkster center is located at 2500 Hamlin Ct. near Michigan Avenue and Inkster Roads (behind the fire station and post office) and phone is 313.561.5100
- Taylor at 26650 Eureka Rd. in the Taylor Human Services Center between Beech Daly and Inkster, call 734.941.4991
- The newest location in Lincoln Park is at Lafayette St./I-75 and W. Outer Dr. at 25650 W. Outer Dr., number is 313.383.1897
